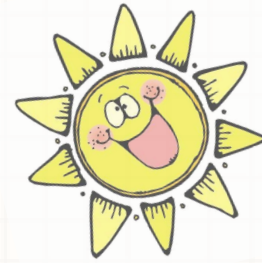

WHAT IS SUNSATATIONS?

Sunsations camps are designed to engage your child in a variety of fun summertime activities!

These camps are split into 4 groups of about 20 children, based on age. These groups participate in different activities each day. Our Sunsations camps philosophy is providing campers with exposure to a variety of fun learning activities. We base our weekly activities on cooking, art, science, sport, and team-building. This means your camper will be engaged with a new and exciting activity everyday!

Every Wednesday, we have a surprise event that will take place at Mid-Sun. Throughout the weeks, these events may include anything from a magician visiting our facility, to an inflatable water slide for water day!

Every Thursday, Sunsations camps visit Midnapore Lake for a day of swimming and summer fun. We have a life guard on staff to ensure your children are safe when in the water.

On Fridays, we visit a new field trip location, visiting places like the Zoo, the Telus science center, and Granary Road.



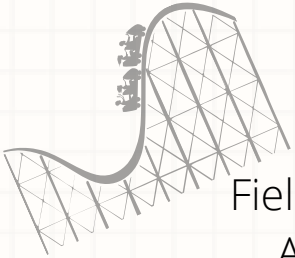

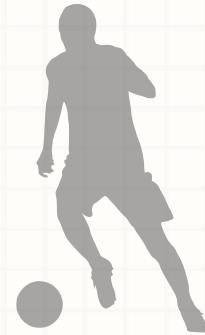
Artrageous (Ages 5–12) \$225

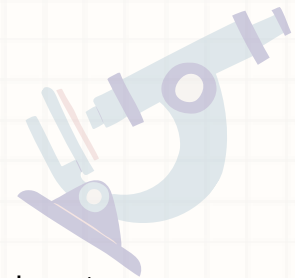
Bike Camp (Ages 8–12) \$225

*Camper must be comfortable swimming



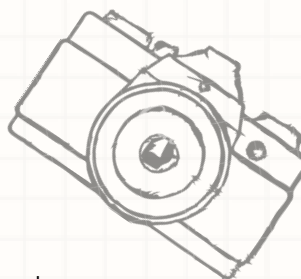
Volleyball Camp (Ages 5–12) \$225

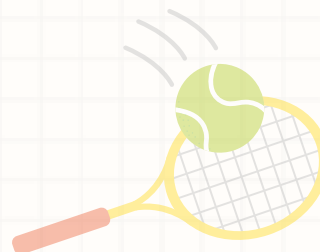

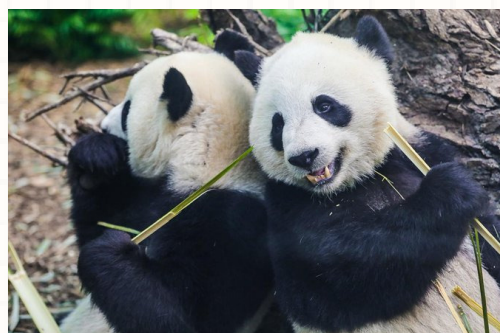

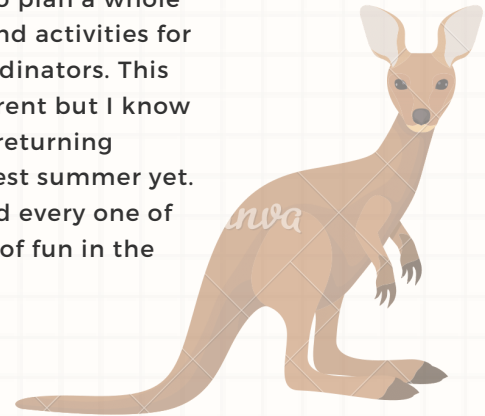
